ConocoPhillips has established **nine lifesaving rules** to promote our commitment to safety.

The rules are specifically aimed at **reducing the risk** of serious incident in critical activities.



Work Permits

Work with a valid work permit when required



Process / Mechanical / Electrical Isolations

Verify isolation before work begins



Driving Safety

Wear your seat belt, obey speed limits and do not use any mobile device while driving



Ground Disturbance / Excavation Work

Obtain authorization before starting ground disturbance or excavation activities



Lifting operations

Follow Safe Lifting Operations and do not walk under a suspended load



Working at Height

Protect yourself against a fall when working at height



Confined Space Entry

Obtain authorization before entering a confined space



Bypassing / Disabling / Inhibiting Safety Devices or Equipment

Obtain authorization before bypassing, disabling or inhibiting a safety protection device or equipment



Line of Fire

Keep yourself and others out of the line of fire

Each of the nine rules has a set of minimum requirements to be followed.
The minimum requirements are adapted to local requirements and practices.

The individual requirements are included in our procedures, which means that if you follow the procedures, you will also have covered the minimum requirements in Life Saving Rules.
