

Purpose: To reduce harm to birds due to contact with:

- Blowdown ponds
- Water hub ponds or facility
- C-rings used for water/fluid and flowback storage

Preventing Birds from Contacting Harmful Process Water

To prevent birds from contacting harmful water sources:

- Physical barricades (e.g., tarps or netting)
- Passive deterrents (e.g., mylar flagging tape and/or effigies)
- Active deterrents (e.g., propane cannons).

Reporting Bird Sightings

Immediately report sightings of the following to the CPC Environmental Coordinator:

- Birds that have contacted process water
- Any bird in distress

Report non-emergency sightings via the Behaviour-Based Safety (BBS) app in Intalex. Include location, behaviour observed, and any other concerns.

Hazing, Capturing and Handling Birds

Hazing, capturing and handling birds must only be done by trained HSE/Environmental Coordinators with proper authorization.

Documenting Bird Risk or Injury

Report the following to the CPC Environmental Coordinator:

- Date and time of initial observation
- Location
- Observer name
- Species
- Nature of bird Risk or Injury
